Honey Cookies

Ingredients

- ☐ 5 eggs
- ☐ 1 cup Dark Brown Sugar
- ☐ 1/4 cup granulated sugar
- ☐ 1/2 cup oil
- ☐ 1 and 1/4 cups Gefen Honey
- ☐ 1 teaspoon cinnamon
- ☐ 1/2 teaspoon salt
- ☐ 1 and 1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- ☐ 5 and 1/2 cups Flour

Bracha

בָּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ
מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם,
בוֹרֵא מִיְּנֵי מְזוֹנוֹת

Baruch Atah Hashem,
Elokeinu Melech HaOlam,
borei minei mezonos.

Directions

1. In a bowl, mix the eggs, dark brown sugar, granulated sugar, oil, and honey until combined.
2. Add cinnamon, salt, baking soda and flour, and mix well to form a dough. Cover and refrigerate for two hours.
3. Preheat oven to 350 degrees Fahrenheit. Line a baking sheet with Gefen Parchment Paper.
4. Shape dough into small balls and place on the baking sheet. Bake for 13 minutes.

And Hashem always welcomes us back with love.



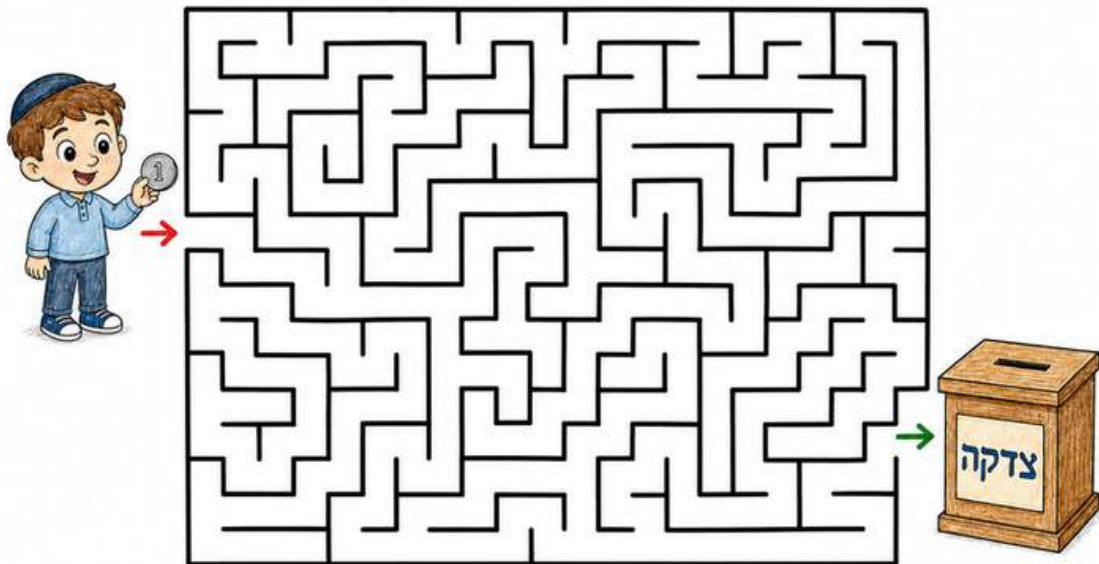
